DESCRIPTION:

This is a management level position that is responsible for developing and supervising professionals who function in multi-discipline project teams. The position requires an individual who can analyze business problems and develop strategies to implement technology or update processes to enable improved business productivity.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Works with senior business stakeholders to define and articulate business strategies.
- Leads the gathering of business needs as well as the design of solutions through direct interaction with business unit leaders, IT, and other staff.
- Consults with business users and technical resources to develop detailed business requirements and related technical options/recommendations.
- Builds detailed business process models to support business solution recommendations.
- Provides overall leadership of program initiatives from assessment through implementation.
- Develops current and future state processes to facilitate validation of solution accuracy and completeness.
- Works with business leaders to gather business needs and functions as a liaison between IT, third party partners and business units in the identification and design of IT related business solutions.
- Demonstrates expertise in IT best practices, solution development, project management, process management, and business requirements definition and methodology.
- Develops the budget to support initiatives.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with a bachelor's degree in Business, Information Systems, Computer Science, or related field.
- Five years or more of professional experience in system development life cycle and business process analysis and design. Experience in business process and object modeling tools and techniques.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- MBA or Masters' Degree
- Experience working in a governmental sector (local, state or federal)
- Experience working with iterative software development methods

- Certified Business Analyst, Professional Business Analyst, Project Management Professional, Lean Six Sigma, Business Process Management or Certified Scrum Master certification.
