2. No limit on Eurasian collared doves; however, any doves not readily identifiable as Eurasian collared doves will be considered mourning doves and count towards the mourning dove daily bag and possession limits.
3. Daily bag limit not to exceed two (2) wood ducks during the Wood Duck/Teal season.

**Regulations for the sandhill crane and late duck and goose seasons will be published in the Waterfowl Hunting Guide available in October. Check TWRA website for updates.**

**Sandhill Crane drawing and season information will be posted on the TWRA website and printed in the Waterfowl Hunting Guide in late September.**



## Important Notice of Ginseng Harvest Season Law Change (TCA 70-8-203)
