Leveraging our 40 technical and community colleges, TBR is actively engaged in the design, implementation, and management of United States Registered Apprenticeship programs. The Center for Workforce Development offers multiple services to assist companies gain access to this proven training pathway. These include:

- 1. **Consulting** with your company to understand workforce and training needs.
- 2. **Designing** registered apprenticeship programs that provide structured on-the-job training along with quality classroom training using in-person and distance education platforms.
- 3. Managing ALL administrative responsibilities of registered apprenticeship programs. Colleges can serve as the sponsor of these programs, which allows companies to focus on their bottom line.
- 4. **Connecting** employers to available state funds that can offset costs associated with the registered apprenticeship training model.

- 94% retention rate nationally among registered apprentices.
- 120% growth of registered apprentices within TBR system in 2019.
- 16 colleges serving as US DOL Registered Apprenticeship sponsors currently in TN.
- State dollars available to offset cost associated with apprenticeship.

5 Elements of Registered Apprenticeship

- **Business Involvement**: Employers are the foundation of every registered apprenticeship program.
- Structured On-the-Job Training: Apprentices receive onthe-job training from an experienced mentor for typically not less than one year.
- Related Instruction: Apprenticeships combine on-thejob learning with technical education at community colleges, technical colleges, apprenticeship training schools, provided online or at the job site.
- **Rewards for Skills Gains**: Apprentices receive increases in wages as they gain higher-level skills.
- National Occupational Credential: Registered apprenticeship programs result in a nationallyrecognized credential—a 100% guarantee to employers that apprentices are fully qualified for the job.
