5. Apprenticeships do not lead to full time work

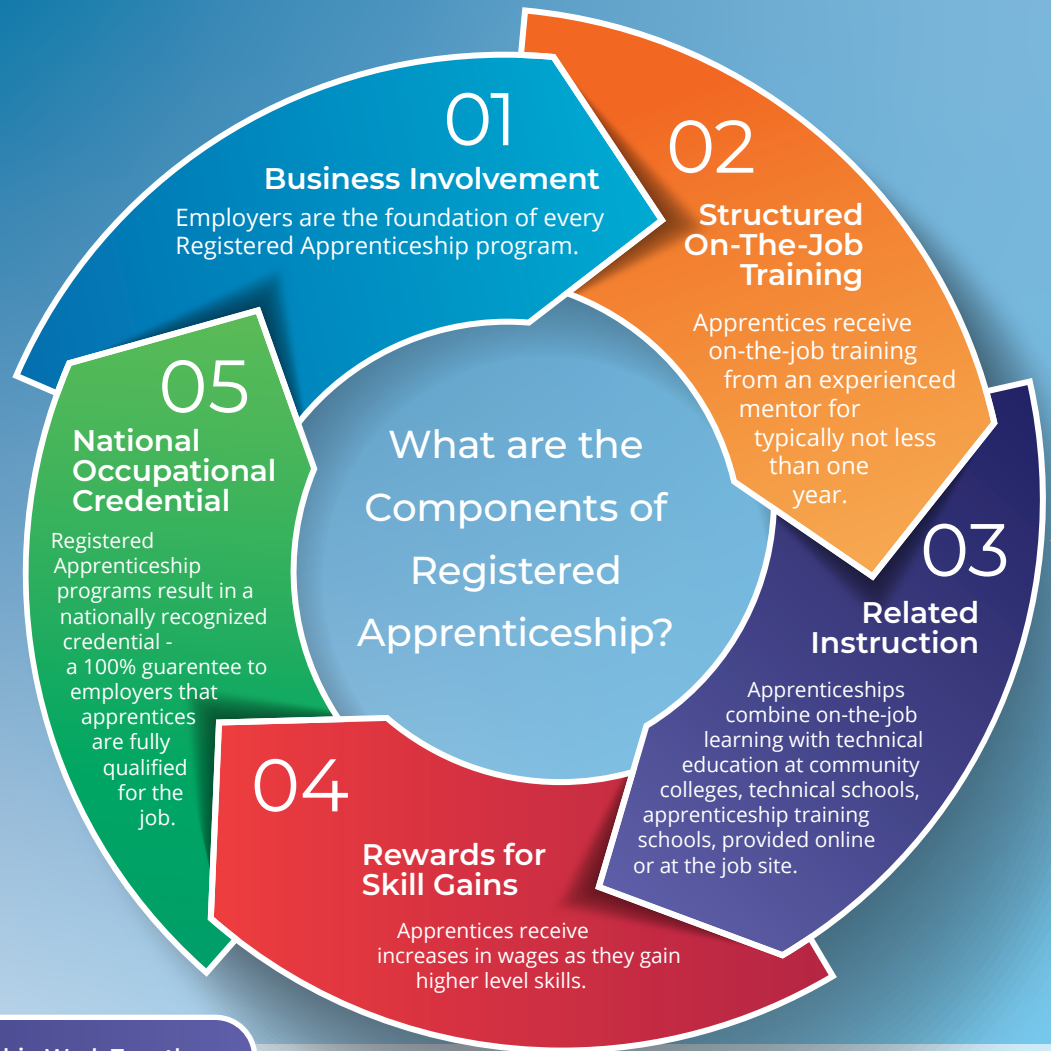
