ORDER OF TIMES, DATES, CONDITIONS AND ARRANGEMENTS FOR LIMITED VISITATION AT GALILEE MEMORIAL GARDENS

The Court adopts the Receiver's plan for opening Galilee Memorial Gardens (the "Cemetery") to the public on a predictable schedule of weekends and holidays but upon the conditions that the visitors proceed at their own risk on the uneven ground of the Cemetery, and that neither the Commissioner nor her Department, the Receiver, Receiver Management, Inc. nor the Court shall monitor or be responsible for these Cemetery visitations. It is therefore ORDERED as follows.

The first day the Cemetery shall be open to the public is Saturday, May 25,
Thereafter the Cemetery shall be open every Saturday and Sunday and holidays to

be designated by the Receiver by a separate proposed order to be filed with the Court listing the designated holidays.

2. On the days the Cemetery is available to the public, the hours shall be 8:30 a.m. opening and 5:30 p.m. closing.

3. The Receiver shall notify the City of Bartlett of the schedule of the opening of the Cemetery so as to allow planning for large crowds potentially present on special days.

4. The Receiver shall arrange for an individual to open and lock the gates on days the Cemetery is open to the public.

5. The Receiver shall have a sign posted at the Cemetery that visitors to the Cemetery proceed at their own risk and are warned to take great care when walking in the Cemetery. Neither the Department of Commerce, Its Commissioner, the Receiver, Receivership Management, Inc. nor this Court shall monitor, have staff present or be responsible for the risks of visitation due to the unevenness of the grounds or any other condition or aspect of the Cemetery.

6. The Receiver shall have a sign posted at the Cemetery with the telephone number of Receivership Management, Inc. for questions about grave space locations, and shall have posted days and hours for gate opening and closing of the Cemetery.

7. The cost of the foregoing visitation arrangements is estimated to be \$160.00 per month for weekends and \$20.00 per holiday, and the Commissioner has agreed and

approved directing funds for these visitation arrangements to be expended from the Cemetery Consumer Protection Account.

8. The Receiver shall publicize the conditions and Cemetery visitation dates and times, and the Clerk and Master has agreed to post the same on the Davidson County Clerk and Master's website.
