#### Opinion No. 03-080

Apportioning TVA Revenue Funds Between County and Special School District

## **QUESTION**

If a county receives TVA revenue funds and uses them for the county school system, must the county share these funds pro rata with a special school district in the county?

# **OPINION**

No. The county is not required by law to share TVA revenue funds with another school district in the county.

# ANALYSIS

The Tennessee Supreme Court has considered this issue and has held "that a county's share of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds, allocated to the County School Fund, is not subject to the provisions of Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-605 [now 49-3-315], and, therefore need not be apportioned among the special school districts of a county." *Conger v. Madison County*, 581 S.W.2d 632, 639 (Tenn. 1979).
