Student Eligibility for Enrollment in Type 1 Charter School

### **QUESTION**

Is it permissible for students who have not been enrolled in a failing school to enroll in a new Type 1 charter school if the local education agency agrees to allow such enrollment?

### **OPINION**

No. The general law, and not the local education agency, determines charter school enrollment eligibility.

# ANALYSIS

We find nothing in the Tennessee Public Charter Schools Act, Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 49-13-101, *et seq.*, that permits a local education agency to modify the statutory criteria for Type 1 charter school enrollment.
