# **Real Estate Appraisers**

comparison, income and cost approach sections. The analysis and presentation set forth in Respondent's reports was not clear and accurate, and for whatever reason, was very misleading. The Commission noted that Respondent was previously disciplined in

February of 2009 for similar USPAP violations.

costs; certificate is suspended for 6 months and indefinitely until penalty and costs are paid; Respondent is not permitted to supervise trainees for 1 year and must provide evidence of completion of 3 corrective education courses within 1 year.
