The below items are brainstorming thoughts of importance from the group – Meeting 2. Reviewed the Chair Subcommittee meeting 1with a lens for school system leadership.

Base Considerations

- needs to be as <u>large</u> as possible to account for array of needs on a per pupil bases. RTI positions, mental wellness personnel, SROs, Social Workers, Counselors, and professional development
- Technology should be considered in the base
- Transportation
- All current elements in the BEP base should be included
- Professional development included a paid for educators
- Resources that support behavioral needs- behavior needs have increased and are not always tied to SWD. Resources for social emotional supports (personnel/curriculum/access to mental health supports); Identification of outcome and success metrics to ensure we are improving (return on investment) *might be reduction in chronic absenteeism, decreased metrics tracking discipline in EIS, increase in grade 3 reading on grade level. Decrease in discipline increases AP time on instruction.
- Base educator/staff (nurses, SROs etc) salary that is competitive to professional labor market values to attract/recruitment/retention; increases overtime

Weight Considerations

- High mobility populations, transient, homeless, High Hispanic populations, ELL needs
- Would like more conversation about the connection to performance metrics to show progress.
