## **Grading and Graduation**

- Question: What are the department recommendations for graduation and proms?
  - RESPONSE: Graduation ceremonies, prom, and decisions about other similar events must be made locally and will certainly look different from community to community. Plans must also be made in compliance with any local safety orders, which vary. The department recommends that school districts consult with school board attorneys, the school board, community leaders, and the local health department in making these decisions. These groups can assist in best determining the needs of the community and how to make these decisions in the best interest of safety.
