Conference

- Question: Any news related to Superintendents Study Council in Gatlinburg?
 - Response: In partnership with the department and TOSS the decision was made to shift the annual Superintendents Study Council conference to a virtual program, rather than convening in Gatlinburg. More information to come.

Stockpile CLP

- **Question:** If we are a stockpile district and our plan shows 6.5 hours of academics is that O.K? 30 minutes of the 7 hour school day is lunch. Do we need to show lunch on our CLP?
 - o **Response:** It is most helpful if districts indicate in some way that they plan to stockpile, and that the remaining 30 minutes per day is the lunch period. They can note that by either including lunch on the schedules they submit, or annotating the schedule they submit to indicate that.
