Re: Waiver for K-3 Classes at Tusculum View Elementary

Dear Mr. Starnes:

I am in receipt of your October 24, 2018 letter requesting a waiver of the class size average for K-3 classes found in T.C.A. §49-1-104 for Tusculum View Elementary for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year.

The commissioner's waiver authority under T.C.A. §49-1-201(d) is limited by T.C.A. §49-1-104(a), which states that "neither the commissioner nor the state board of education shall grant waivers from the maximum class sizes established in this section."

With the understanding that none of the K-3 classes at Tusculum View Elementary will exceed 25, the maximum number of students per class specified in the above referenced law, your request for a waiver of the class size average is granted for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year.

Dear Commissioner McQueen,

The Greeneville City Schools Board of Education would like to request a waiver of the class size average mandates in grades K-3 for Tusculum View Elementary. The school will continue to adhere to the class size maximums for all grades.

The current K-3 class average at Tusculum View Elementary, is 20.3. The Greeneville City School district goes above state requirements in every area of teacher and student support. All kindergarten classes at the school have a teacher assistant that is fully dedicated to each classroom. There are also additional adult supports in place in all classrooms in grades 1-3 with additional teacher assistant time, as well as additional classroom support from related arts teachers. The school has 2-3 adults in each classroom for the majority of the day.

We will adjust staffing prior to the 2019-2020 school year. However, this waiver is needed for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year. Please let me know if you need additional information or further clarification or justification for this request.
