Sumner County Schools (SCS)

Description of the violations:

SCS failed to provide Student with special transportation in accordance with his IEP.

Description of the law or regulation determined to be violated:

34 C.F.R. §300.139(b) Special Transportation

34 C.F.R. §300.17 FAPE TN SBOE Rule 0520-01-09-.05. FAPE

SCS must correct these violations by implementing the following corrective actions:

- 1. Provide training for all appropriate staff on the aforementioned regulations no later than 8/15/20;
- 2. Within ten (10) days of completion of training, provide the department with an agenda, content, and sign-in sheets as documentation of appropriate training content and appropriate staff participation;
- 3. As soon as possible, but no later than the first day of the 2020-21 school year, Student's IEP team must meet (in person or virtually) to determine how special transportation will be provided going forward in accordance with Student's IEP. Within ten (10) days of completion of the IEP meeting, provide the department with documentation of the IEP team's decisions; and
- 4. SCS must calculate and provide to Complainant mileage compensation for the transportation of Student to and from his private preschool facility to his IEP services from the dates of 2/4/20 through 3/12/20.

Final determination of the department: The Department will monitor and document SCS compliance with corrective measures ordered.
