- 3. Once completed, submit to the department all finalized, signed IEP documentation; to include the appropriate invitation, IEP, and PWN;
- 4. Participate in a department led training on restraint and isolation (SEBSA) for all school administrators, special education staff, and any other staff deemed appropriate by WCS; and
- 5. Within ten (10) days of completion of training provide the department of the agenda, content, and sign-in sheets of participants as documentation of appropriate training content and appropriate staff participation.

Final determination of the department: The department will monitor and document WCS compliance with corrective measures ordered.
