Name of the school system:

Johnson County Schools (JCS)

Description of the violation:

JCS failed to implement Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) teacher services as written in Student's IEP since returning from spring break.

Description of the law or regulation determined to be violated:

34 C.F.R. § 300.101(a)	FAPE
34 C.F.R. § 300.323	IEPs

JCS must correct these violations by implementing the following corrective actions:

Student Level Corrections:

- 1. Within 10 days of receipt of this letter, MSCS is required to convene an IEP meeting to determine the need for compensatory education services for all missed IEP service hours; and
- 2. The signed written compensatory education agreement, complete with Complainant's signature, must be submitted to the department after the IEP meeting required by Student Level Correction #1.

District Level Corrections:

- 1. Upon receipt of this letter, JCS is required to provide Student with a certified/endorsed DHH teacher. If JCS does not employ a currently endorsed teacher to fulfill this obligation, JCS is required to contract with a neighboring district in order to meet the requirements;
- 2. Within 10 days of securing a DHH teacher, JCS is required to provide the department with evidence that step #2 has been met;
- 3. Evaluate the impact of the lack of personnel at issue in this complaint on each impacted student specific to their provision of FAPE at JCS for any services not provided during the 2021-22 school year;
- 4. Submit evidence of this evaluation to the department by 08/15/22;
- 5. Communicate these evaluation results to parents upon completion and submit evidence of parental communication to the department;
- 6. Convene IEP meetings within ten (10) days of this evaluation for any student identified in School Level Correction #3 to determine the need for compensatory education services for any missed IEP services; and
- 7. Submit to the department signed documentation of written compensatory education agreements by 8/31/22.

Final determination of the department: The department will monitor and document JCS compliance with corrective measures ordered.
