

IDEA WRITTEN ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT NUMBER 14-04

Name of the school system:

Hamilton County Schools

Description of the violation:

Hamilton County Schools failed to notify a student's parent of a restraint on the same day and report the incident to designated administrative staff.

Hamilton County Schools staff failed to be informed of his or her specific responsibilities related to implementing the child's IEP and the specific accommodations, modifications, and supports that must be provided for the child in accordance with the Individual Education Program (IEP).

Description of the law or regulation determined to have been violated:

- The Special Education Behavioral Supports Act at T.C.A. Chapter 49-10-1304 (d) and (e)
- IDEA Regulation 34 C.F.R. §300.323(d) (2)

Corrective measures ordered by the department:

Hamilton County Schools must correct the violations by implementing the following corrective action:

- Hamilton County Schools must schedule and arrange training regarding the aforementioned regulations, as mandated by the IDEA and state special education laws, to the appropriate staff of Hamilton County Schools.
- Hamilton County Schools must schedule training on classroom intervention and prevention strategies with Tennessee Department of Education, Division of Special Populations staff.
- Hamilton County Schools must notify and provide documentation to the Tennessee Department of Education upon completion of the corrective action plan.

Final determination of the department:

The Department will monitor Hamilton County Schools for compliance of the correction action plan.
