Name of the school system:

Metropolitan Nashville Public Schools (MNPS)

Description of the violations:

Failure to provide all IEP services due to personnel shortage

Description of the laws or regulations determined to be violated:

34 CFR §300.114 "Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) Requirements"

Corrective measures ordered by the department:

MCSS must correct this violation by implementing the following corrective actions:

1. Within sixty (60) days of receipt of this report, conduct training for all appropriate staff. The district must inform the complaint investigator of the training date as soon as it is selected.
2. Provide documentation of the training, including agenda, content, and sign-in sheet, within ten (10) days of the training's completion.
3. Provide the department with an update on Student's provision of services by January 10, 2019 after school reconvenes from the midyear holiday. This update should include a schedule showing hours of full participation in the general education setting, provision of student's assistant at all required times, and grades or other reports supporting progress made or not made from the start of the 2018-19 school year.

Final determination of the department:

The Department will monitor and document MNPS compliance with corrective actions ordered.
