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Preschool

Users in TN PULSE can access the **Early Childhood Outcomes (ECO)** and the **TN Early Intervention Data System (TEIDS)** after selecting a student. After a student has been selected, select **Student Info** and then **Preschool** from the Main Menu.

Preschool Transition

Data from the **TN Early Intervention System (TEIS)** will automatically upload into TN PULSE on the 5th and 20th of each month. Select the **Transition** tab to view data imported from TEIDS. The student must have a **State ID Number** recorded in the TEIDS system as well as a **TEIS Transition Meeting Date**.

Select the **Transition** tab on the **Preschool** page and enter information for **Notification/Referral**, **Eligiblity**, and **IFSP**. Lastly, complete the student's **Developmental Information**. Select **Save and Continue** once completed.

Early Childhood Outcomes

Select the **Early Childhood Outcomes** (ECO) tab from the **Preschool** page and enter the **ECO Entrance** and **Exit Dates** on students' ages three to five-years old (not in kindergarten).

On the **Early Childhood Outcomes** page, users should enter **TEIS Early Childhood Outcomes Data** to populate the **Entrance Data** on the left side, while the user should enter **LEA Early Childhood Outcomes Data** for the **Exit Data** on the right.

Use the Rules at the top of the page to enter appropriate answers from the dropdown in the fields provided for TEIS and ECO Exit Reasons. For additional ECO resources, select the following links:

- Select the response from the dropdown menus to document progress for LEA Early Childhood Outcome Exit Reasons 1, 2, and 3 in appropriate text fields.

Preschool Least Restrictive Environment (LRE)

Documenting the most appropriate educational environment must be completed at each IEP meeting for student's whose age at the IEP Start Date or Date of IEP Addendum is between three and six years old who are enrolled in a preschool program. The following steps allow TN PULSE users to document the most appropriate educational environment.

- From the **Preschool** page, select the **Preschool LRE** tab.
- Select Enter ED Environment Data.
- Use the key at the top of the page to determine what is classified as a regular preschool program.
- Follow the decision tree to make the appropriate selections from the dropdown menus based on the amount and location of services in the current IEP.
- Select **View Previous Placement** to show previous preschool placement event details.

- 3. Select the **Location of Services**.
- 4. Enter the name of the parent or guardian-provided regular preschool program.
- 5. Determine where the child receives majority of special education and/or related services.
- 6. Select **Save and Continue** once completed.
