








Understanding Grant Hierarchy



Project Costing (PC)

- Manages project control
- ➤ Stores Project and Activity information
- ➤ Stores transactional data associated with Grant Projects
- ➤ Directs F&A (Indirect Cost) processing
- Accesses project budgets in Commitment Control

Customer (revenue) Contracts

- Stores contract lines and associated accounting rate sets
- >Used to process billing and record revenue
- > Creates interface file of billable transactions
- ➤ Helps control grantor draws by storing contract billing limit information
- Links the Project Costing to the Billing
- Links the Project Costing to Accounts Receivable

Customer (revenue) Contracts

- > Facilitates billing of external customers/sponsors
- ➤ Generates support for the billing of interdepartmental customers/sponsors
- ➤ Uses billing plan to bundle billable transactions for awards with multiple projects
- ➤ Stores revenue recognition plan and creates Unbilled Accounts Receivable (UAR)/revenue journal
- Facilitates accounting and utilization of Prepaid/Advance amounts received

Billing

- ➤ Interfaces with Customer Contracts to create bill lines
- ➤ Creates a temporary billing worksheet used to make grantor draws
- ➤ Transfers transactional data related to approved and billed rows back to Project Costing
- ➤ Integrates with Accounts Receivable to establish the AR for the project and creates the AR/Unbilled AR journal

Accounts Receivable

- Stores information on accounts receivable (AR Items)
- ➤ Interfaces with iNovah, the State's cashiering system, to receipt deposits and post payments received
- Integrates back to Projects and Customer Contracts to update the source transaction with billed accounts receivable invoice item(s) and billed dates
- ➤ Used to apply deposits to outstanding AR open Items

Human Capital Management (HCM)/Payroll

- Stores Principal (PI) information that is necessary to create a Proposal
- ➤ Stores task profiles used to charge Time and Labor expenditures to grant projects
- > Sends transactional information to Project Costing

General Ledger

- Houses GL Journals which record transactions directly to the state's general ledger that is comprised of equal and offsetting debits & credits and contain project costing chartfields
- ➤ Houses GL journals which record statistical entries to produce revenue & billing transactions in the Customer Contract
- > Receives & houses subsystem journals related to PC
- >Sends & receives transaction information from PC

Commitment Control

- Maintains project budgets
- Controls project expenditures against predefined, authorized budgets

Purchasing

- Houses procurement requisitions, supplier contracts, and purchase orders related to grant projects
- Sends and receives transactional information from Project Costing

Accounts Payable

- > Houses accounts payable invoice transactions
- Receives travel transactions from the Travel module for payment processing
- ➤ Sends and receives transactions information from Project Costing

Travel


- Houses travel transactions
- > Sends transactional information to Project Costing
- Default travel accounting comes from the Task Profile/Speedchart accounting defaults

Inventory

- > Houses inventory records and transactions
- ➤ Sends and receives transactions information from Project Costing
