### GRANTS.GOV WORKSPACE OVERVIEW

- Grants.Gov Workspace
  - 1. Multiple users can complete the application forms.
  - 2. Existing Workspace forms can be reused or copied.
  - 3. Upfront validation allows applicants to correct application errors prior to submission.
  - 4. Seamless integration between online webforms and offline PDF forms.
  - 5. Immediately reflected changes to the Opportunity Package.



### PC 79 (TCA 4-4-113)

### **❖** Public Chapter 79 (<u>TCA 4-4-113</u>):

- Requires all State Departments receiving federal financial assistance to report any official notice related to noncompliance received.
- 2. Developed the <u>PC79 Form</u> to assist with compliance of the notification requirements.
- 3. A Public Chapter 79 guideline document.



### PC 79 TEMPLATE DEMO

- ♦ How to fill out PC79 Form
  - >Section | General information
    - 1. Your agency name
    - 2. CFDA Number, see <u>CFDA website</u> if you do not see it on your notice letter from Federal agency or cognizant agency.
    - 3. Federal Program name
    - 4. Is this a follow-up notification to a previously reported item?

### PC 79 TEMPLATE DEMO-CONTINUED

#### How to fill out PC79 Form

  - 1. Federal entity providing notification
  - 2. Name of reporting federal agency
  - 3. Federal reference number, if provided
  - 4. Form of notification received, If other, please describe:

### WHY PRE-AWARD RISK ASSESSMENT

- Oversight and internal control to provide reasonable assurance grants are awarded properly, recipients are eligible, and federal grant funds are used as intended.
- ❖ 25 Single Audit Findings in FY 2016 pertained to subrecipients.
- Proactive approach vs. reactive approach.
- \* Result in a more efficient and effective approach to grants management.
- Department of Education Case Study.



# PRE-AWARD RISK ASSESSMENT BENEFITS

- 1. Decide which of several prospective subrecipients to select for a particular activity.
- 2. Identify early training and technical assistant to provide to potential subrecipients lacking previous experience.
- 3. Develop subaward agreement that implements appropriate oversight and monitoring mechanisms.
- 4. Provides information needed to effectively target resources to grantees that pose the greatest risk to the integrity of the programs.
- 5. Reduce the risk of major compliance related problems including waste, fraud, and abuse.
- 6. Increase the potential for success.



- To assess the risk posed by applicants prior to making a subaward as well as assessing risk to determine monitoring procedures.
  - 1. Eligibility Requirements
  - 2. Experience Level of Staff/Management
  - 2. Financial Management and Accounting
  - 3. Past Performance/Audit Results

- How to fill out <u>Risk Assessment Template</u>:
  - Risk assessment tool:
    - > Part I. General eligibility
      - 1. Determine an eligibility
    - > Part II. Risk assessment for the applicant/subrecipient
      - 1. Evaluate the risk proposed by applicant
      - 2. Assessment for accounting system, staff changes, financial management, past performance to reporting & budget.
