


MATERNAL HOMICIDES IN TENNESSEE, 2017-2020

Maternal homicides are those occurring during pregnancy or within a year of pregnancy

homicides occurred between 2017 and 2020 of the 56 violent maternal deaths


The median age of the women who died from the homicides




of the homicides were from metro areas of Tennessee

Of the top 3 means of fatal injury, firearm was the most common



All women who died by pregnancy related death were killed by their partners

PREGNANCY RELATEDNESS?

71%

of the homicides were not aggravated by pregnancy.

RISK?

Intimate Partner Violence

1 in 2 experienced Intimate Partner Violence (IPV), violence by their current or former romantic partner.



of the 38 homicides were perpetuated by the partner or ex-partner

Opportunities for prevention

- Participating in Danger Assessment Training
- Incorporating IPV screening into protocols
- Identify, screen and refer to resources for domestic violence
