

REINSTATEMENT REQUIREMENTS

Emergency Medical Responder

- 1. THOSE THAT HAVE AN **EXPIRED** CERTIFICATION AND ARE **WITHIN 60 DAYS** OF THEIR EXPIRATION DATE MUST:
 - > Submit proof of successfully completing <u>one</u> of the following that was <u>taken/obtained within renewal cycle:</u>
 If not met within cycle then you must complete all items in #2 below
 - 10 continuing education hours and proof of skills competency *OR*
 - 16 hour refresher course

OR

- National Registry EMR assessment examination
- > Submit a completed renewal invoice or professional fee form
- > Submit the renewal fee of \$24.00
- > Submit the late fee of \$25.00
- > Submit verification of your current CPR Training/Card
- 2. THOSE THAT HAVE A CERTIFICATION THAT IS EXPIRED **GREATER THAN 60 DAYS** AND **LESS THAN 2 YEAR** MUST:
 - ➤ Successfully complete the National Registry **EMR assessment examination**
 - > Submit verification of completion of the **16 hour refresher course**
 - > Submit a completed renewal invoice or professional fee form
 - > Submit the renewal fee of \$24.00
 - > Submit the reinstatement fee of \$50.00
 - ➤ Submit verification of your <u>current</u> **CPR Training/Card**
- 3. THOSE THAT HAVE A LICENSE THAT IS EXPIRED GREATER THAN 2 YEAR MUST COMPLETE THE INITIAL COURSE IN ITS ENTIRETY AND APPLY FOR A NEW LICENSE.
