

COVID Vaccination and Tennessee Ryan White Clients

Background

The Tennessee Department of Health, and the metro health departments of Nashville/Davidson, Memphis/Shelby, Knoxville/Knox, Jackson/Madison, Chattanooga/Hamilton, and Johnson City/Sullivan have opened up COVID vaccinations to all individuals 16 years and older.

It is highly encouraged for all Ryan White clients to sign-up and receive their COVID vaccine as soon as possible.

Scheduling your COVID Vaccination Appointment

- **Walk-ups are Accepted Daily at State Health Departments**
- *Via your county health department* at: COVID19.tn.gov
 - Provides phone numbers and the ability to request a vaccine appointment online
- *Via Vaccine Finder* (<https://vaccinefinder.org/search/>), which allows persons to enter their zip code and find nearby government, private health providers, and pharmacies (Kroger, Walmart, Publix, and local pharmacies) that are providing the COVID vaccine
 - The website provides phone numbers and websites for setting-up an appointment
- *COVID Vaccine Appointment Phone Number for Rural Area Appointments*- **866-442-5301**
 - A person can speak with another person to schedule a COVID vaccine appointment
 - This is for scheduling appointments for the COVID vaccines at rural county health departments only.

Other Information

- When signing-up for a COVID vaccine appointment you should not be asked or requested to provide more information about your immunocompromised condition.
- Additionally, you do not need a note from your health care provider proving that you are in a high-risk population in order to receive your COVID vaccine.
