**One of the substantiated instances (Lack of Supervision) occurred at a facility that administers both a TDHS licensed and a TDOE Pre-K program. The TDOE Pre-K program is not a participant in the child care certificate program.							

**Serious Injuries** – Child care agencies are required to report any incidents involving a child in its care (including on and off-site activities) where treatment by a medical professional was necessary. It does not include instances where a medical professional examines the child but determines that no injury occurred, or treatment is not necessary.

**Substantiated Instances of Child Abuse** - There were ten instances of child abuse substantiated by the Department of Children’s Services in child care agencies during the reporting period:

- Lack of Supervision (5)
- Physical Abuse (4)

**Child Deaths** – There were no child deaths in licensed child care facilities during the period.
