Dear Mr. Evans.

The Department of Human Services (DHS) - Division of Audit Services staff conducted a desk review of the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) at Child Development Schools, Incorporated, (Sponsor), Application Agreement number 00201, on April 22, 2020. The purpose of this review was to determine if the Sponsor complied with the *Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) applicable parts, provider agreement, and applicable Federal and State regulations.

Based on our review of the Sponsor's records and information provided, the Sponsor had seven (7) feeding sites operating during the review period. The centers CNI #34, CNI #135, and CNI #168 were selected as the sample.

Background

CACFP Sponsors utilize meal count sheets to record the number of breakfast, lunch, supper, and supplement meals served. Meals served by participating Sponsors must meet the minimum guidelines set by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and DHS to be eligible for reimbursement. The CACFP Sponsor reports the number of meals served through the DHS Tennessee Information Payment System (TIPS) to seek reimbursement.

We inspected meal count sheets for our test period and reconciled the meals claimed to the meals reported as served for each meal service. We also assessed compliance with civil rights requirements. We observed a PM supplement meal service at CNI #34 on March 10, 2020, a breakfast service at CNI #135 on March 10, 2020, and a lunch service at CNI #168 on March 10, 2020. Our review revealed no deficiencies.

Our review of the sponsor's records for March 2020 disclosed the following:

1. The Sponsor incorrectly reported the number of meals served the date of the monitoring site visit

Condition

Based on our observation and our review of the Claim for Reimbursement for March 2020, we found the number of meals claimed at two sites differed from the number claimed as follows:

As a result, four (4) breakfast meals were underreported and three (3) supplements were over claimed.

<u>Criteria</u>

Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.10(c) states, "... In submitting a Claim for Reimbursement, each institution shall certify that the claim is correct and that records are available to support that claim..."

Recommendation

The Sponsor should ensure that claims for reimbursement are completed correctly and based on accurate supporting documents.

2. The Sponsor did not complete monitoring of its feeding sites as required

Condition

Based on our review of the monitoring documents provided, we noted that the forms completed on August 28, 2019 (at CNI #135) and December 19, 2019 (at CNI #34 and #135) showed no indication of whether the visits were announced or unannounced.

Criteria

Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.16(d)(4)(iii) states, "... "Sponsoring organizations must review each facility three times each year, except as described in paragraph (d)(4)(iv) of this section. In addition: (A) at least two of the three reviews must be unannounced; (B) At least one unannounced review must include observation of a meal service; (C) At least one review must be made during each new facility's first four weeks of Program operations; and (D) Not more than six months may elapse between reviews."

Recommendation

The Sponsor should ensure that monitoring documents are completed correctly to demonstrate

compliance with requirements.

Technical Assistance Provided

Technical assistance was provided via email regarding required postings and infant menus on March 10, 2020.

Corrective Action

The Sponsor must complete the following actions within 30 days from the date of this report:
