Dear Ms. Porter,

The Department of Human Services (DHS) - Division of Audit Services staff conducted an unannounced on-site monitoring review of the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) at Little Miss Mag Day Care Center (Sponsor), Application Agreement number 00391, beginning on February 19, 2020. The purpose of this review was to determine if the Sponsor complied with the *Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) applicable parts, provider agreement, and applicable Federal and State regulations.

## Background

CACFP Sponsors utilize meal count sheets to record the number of breakfasts, lunch, supper, and supplement meals served. Meals served by participating Sponsors must meet the minimum guidelines set by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and DHS to be eligible for reimbursement. The CACFP Sponsor reports the number of meals served through the DHS Tennessee Information Payment System (TIPS) for reimbursement.

We inspected meal counts sheets for our test period and reconciled the meals claimed to the meals reported as served for each meal service. We also assessed compliance with civil rights requirements. In addition, we observed a lunch meal service on January 15, 2020.

Our review of the Sponsor's records for January 2020 disclosed the following:

# 1. The Sponsor reported the number of participants in the free, reduced-price, and paid categories incorrectly

## Condition

Based on our review of the Claim for Reimbursement for January 2020, we noted that the Sponsor reported 27 participants in the free category, 12 participants in the reduced-price

category, and 77 participants in the paid category. However, based on our review, we noted that there were 20 participants in the free category, 12 participants in the reduced-price category, and 84 participants in the paid category.

The differences were based on the following:

- There were two (2) participants reported in the free category whose CACFP applications were incorrectly classified based on the income reported requirements. These participants were reclassified as reduced-price.
- The number of participants reported in the free category was overreported by five (5) participants, the reduced-price category was overreported by two (2) participants and the paid category was underreported by seven (7) participants.

As a result, the Sponsor overreported the number of participants in the free category by seven (7) participants and underreported the number of participants in the paid category by seven (7) participants. (See Exhibit)

## This is a repeat finding from a previous report dated April 10, 2017.

## <u>Criteria</u>

*Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.10(c)* states, "... In submitting a Claim for Reimbursement, each institution shall certify that the claim is correct and that records are available to support that claim ..."

*Title* 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.15(e)(2) states, "All types of centers, except for emergency shelters and at-risk afterschool care centers, must maintain information used to determine eligibility for free or reduced-price meals in accordance with 226.23(e)(1). For child care centers, such documentation of enrollment must be updated annually, signed by a parent or legal guardian, and include information on each child's normal days and hours of care and the meals normally received while in care."

*Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.17(b)(8)* states, in part, "Child care centers shall collect and maintain documentation of the enrollment of each child, including information used to determine eligibility for free and reduced price meals in accordance with §226.23(e)(1)..."

## Recommendation

The Sponsor should maintain all information used to determine eligibility and ensure that each participant is classified and reported accurately based on categorical or income eligibility.

## 2. The Sponsor reported meal counts incorrectly

## **Condition**

Based on our review of the Claim for Reimbursement for January 2020, the Sponsor claimed 1,422 breakfast meals, 2,008 lunch meals, and 1,962 supplements served. However, based on our review of the available documents, we noted that there were 1,463 breakfast meals, 2,066 lunch meals, and 2,037 supplements, prior to any meal disallowances.

As a result, 41 breakfast meals, 58 lunch meals and 75 supplements served were underreported. (See Exhibit)

## This is a repeat finding from a previous report dated April 10, 2017.

## <u>Criteria</u>

*Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.10(c)* states, "… In submitting a Claim for Reimbursement, each institution shall certify that the claim is correct and that records are available to support that claim…."

## Recommendation

The Sponsor should ensure that claims for reimbursement are completed correctly and based on accurate supporting documents.

## 3. The Sponsor provided menus that did not meet the USDA meal pattern requirements

**Condition** 

Based on our review of the menus provided by the Sponsor for January 2020, the menus provided did not meet the USDA meal pattern requirements. The menus provided had deficiencies as follows:

Due to the new CACFP infant meal pattern requirements and emphasis on providing technical assistance during the implementation process, there were no meals disallowed.

## <u>Criteria</u>

*Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.14 (b)* states, "In the event that the State agency finds that an institution which prepares its own meals is failing to meet the meal requirements of 226.20, the State agency need not disallow payment or collect an overpayment arising out of such failure if the institution takes such other action as, in the opinion of the State agency, will have a corrective effect.".

*Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 226.20(b)(1) states, "Foods in reimbursable meals served to infants ages birth through 11 months must be of a texture and a consistency that are appropriate for the age and development of the infant being fed. Foods must also be served during a span of time consistent with the infant's eating habits."

Section 226.20(b)(2) states, "Breastmilk or iron-fortified infant formula, or portions of both, must be served to infants birth through 11 months of age. An institution or facility must offer at least one type of iron-fortified infant formula. Meals containing breastmilk or iron-fortified infant formula supplied by the institution or facility, or by the parent or guardian, are eligible for reimbursement."

For children six through 11 months old, Section 226.20(b)(4)(ii) states, "Breastmilk or ironfortified formula, or portions of both, is required. Meals are reimbursable when institutions and facilities provide all the components in the meal pattern that the infant is developmentally ready to accept.

Section 226.20(b)(4)(ii)(A) states that at breakfast, lunch, or supper, "Six to 8 fluid ounces of breastmilk or iron-fortified infant formula, or portions of both; and 0 to 4 tablespoons of iron-fortified dry infant cereal, meat, fish, poultry, whole egg, cooked dry beans, or cooked dry peas; or 0 to 2 ounces (weight) of cheese; or 0 to 4 ounces (volume) of cottage cheese; or 0 to 8 ounces of yogurt; and 0 to 2 tablespoons of vegetable, fruit, or portions of both. Fruit juices and vegetable juices must not be served."

Section 226.20(b)(4)(ii)(B) requires for a reimbursable snack, "Two to 4 fluid ounces of breastmilk or iron-fortified infant formula; and 0 to  $\frac{1}{2}$  slice bread; or 0-2 crackers; or 0-4 tablespoons infant cereal or ready-to-eat cereals; and 0 to 2 tablespoons of vegetable or fruit, or portions of both. Fruit juices and vegetable juices must not be served. A serving of grains must be whole grain-rich, enriched meal, or enriched flour."

## **Recommendation**

The Sponsor should ensure that all meals claimed for reimbursement meet the meal patterns established by the USDA, and menus should be reviewed to ensure they contain all required meal components to be eligible as a reimbursable meal.

## 4. The Sponsor reported the number of attendance days incorrectly

## **Condition**

Based on our review of the Claim for Reimbursement for January 2020, the Sponsor reported 2,147 participant days. However, we noted that there were 2,041 participant days.

## <u>Criteria</u>

*Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.10(c)* states, "…In submitting a Claim for Reimbursement, each institution shall certify that the claim is correct and that records are available to support that claim. …."

## Recommendation

The Sponsor should ensure that all participants are recorded as present only for their actual days of attendance.

## 5. The Sponsor reported meals that exceed attendance

## **Condition**

Based on our review of the Claim for Reimbursement for January 2020, we noted that there were 2,066 lunch meals claimed for reimbursement, which exceeds the verified attendance of 2,041 by 25 meals.

As a result, 25 lunch meals claimed for reimbursement were disallowed. (See Exhibit)

## <u>Criteria</u>

*Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.10(c)* states, "... In submitting a Claim for Reimbursement, each institution shall certify that the claim is correct and that records are available to support that claim ..."

## Recommendation

The Sponsor should ensure that accurate attendance and meal counts are kept on a daily basis.

## **Technical Assistance Provided**

During our monitoring visit on January 19, 2020, the Sponsor requested technical assistance regarding the updated USDA meal pattern requirements effective October 1, 2017 for infant meal patterns. We provided assistance during the visit.

#### **Disallowed Meals Cost**

Based on the review, we determined that the Sponsor's noncompliance with the applicable Federal and State regulations that govern the CACFP resulted in a total disallowed cost of \$513.70.

## **Corrective Action**

The Sponsor should complete the following actions within 30 days from the date of this report:

- Log into the Tennessee Information Payment System (TIPS) and revise the claim submitted for January 2020, which contains the verified claim data from the enclosed exhibits. <u>Please note that, if the claim is revised</u>, TIPS will automatically deduct the overpayment from your next CACFP claim for reimbursement. <u>OR</u>
- If you are no longer participating in the CACFP program, remit a check payable to the Tennessee Department of Human Services in the amount noted in the report for recovery of the amounts disallowed in this report. Please return the attached billing notice with your check; and
