Dear Mr. Newman,

The Department of Human Services (DHS) - Division of Audit Services staff conducted an unannounced on-site monitoring review of the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) at South Central Human Resource Agency (Sponsor), Application Agreement number 00501, on January 7, 2019. The purpose of this review was to determine if the Sponsor complied with the *Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) applicable parts, provider agreement, and applicable Federal and State regulations.

Based on our review of the Sponsor's records and information provided, the Sponsor had 22 feeding sites operating during the review period. Lincoln County Head Start (Lincoln), Marshall County Head Start II (Marshall), Northridge Head Start (Northridge) and Tullahoma Head Start (Tullahoma) were selected as the sample.

Background

CACFP Sponsors utilize meal count sheets to record the number of breakfast, lunch, supper, and supplement meals served. Meals served by participating Sponsors must meet the minimum guidelines set by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and DHS to be eligible for reimbursement. The CACFP Sponsor reports the number of meals served through the DHS Tennessee Information Payment System (TIPS) for reimbursement.

We inspected meal count sheets for our test period and reconciled the meals claimed to the meals reported as served for each meal service. We also assessed compliance with civil rights requirements. In addition, we observed a meal service at each of the sample sites during the month of November 2019.

Our review of the Sponsor's records for November 2019 revealed the following:

The Sponsor claimed more meals than we observed

Condition

During our monitoring visits at three sites, we observed fewer meals than the number claimed for reimbursement. Below is a summary of the discrepancies:

As a result, one (1) breakfast, four (4) lunches and one (1) PM supplement claimed for reimbursement were disallowed.

<u>Criteria</u>

Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 225.15(c)(1) states, "Sponsors shall maintain accurate records which justify all costs and meals claimed. Failure to maintain such records may be grounds for denial of reimbursement for meals served and/or administrative costs claimed during the period covered by the records in question...."

Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 226.10 (c) states, "...In submitting a Claim for Reimbursement, each institution shall certify that the claim is correct and that records are available to support that claim...."

Recommendation

The Sponsor should ensure that the number of meals claimed for reimbursement is based on the actual number of meals served.

Technical Assistance Provided

Technical assistance was offered however it was declined by the Sponsor.

Disallowed Meals Cost

The disallowed meals cost associated with the finding above is below the DHS threshold for repayment.

Corrective Action

The Sponsor must complete the following actions within 30 days from the date of this report:

• Prepare and submit a corrective action plan to address the deficiencies identified in this report. The corrective action plan template is attached. Please return the corrective action plan to:
