




Job Attainment Rate – Number of people who worked at least one day divided by the total number served


Job Retention Rate – Number of people who worked 90 days or more divided by the number who worked at least 1 day

Average Hours Worked and Wage Earned


- Average Wage: \$12.08
 - -TN Minimum Wage: \$7.25
- Average Hours per Week: 30.6
 - -Standard Full-Time Employment: 40
 - -VR Requirement: 15

Demographic Breakdown: Race




Demographics: Ethnicity




- Non-Hispanic population: 96%

Demographic Breakdown: Age




Demographic Breakdown: Gender



Benefits Reduced because of work


