- (8) Providing information and educational activities to persons within ResellerI and training such persons to seek out, encourage, and promote the use of small and minority-owned businesses.

In performance of these duties, the Administrator will utilize a number of resources, including:

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The National Association of Women Business Owners

The National Association of Minority Contractors

Historically Black Colleges, Universities, and Minority Institutions

The efforts to promote and ensure equal opportunities for small and minority-

owned businesses are primarily spelled out in the Administrator's duties above.

Additional efforts to provide opportunities to small and minority-owned businesses will

include offering, where appropriate and feasible, small and minority-owned businesses

assistance with technical, insurance, bonding, licensing, production, and deadline

requirements.

IV. RECORDS AND COMPLIANCE REPORTS

ResellerI will maintain records of qualified small and minority-owned business

and efforts to use the goods and services of such businesses. In addition, ResellerI will

maintain records of educational and training activities conducted or attended and of the

internal procurement procedures adopted to support this plan.

ResellerI will submit records and reports required by the Tennessee Public Utility

Commission concerning the Plan. Moreover, ResellerI will cooperate fully with any surveys

and studies required by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission.
