NOTICE ON PUBLIC COMMENT IN COMMISSION PROCEEDINGS

The Tennessee Public Utility Commission is the regulatory body that governs private investor-owned public utilities in the state of Tennessee. For the benefit of Tennessee citizens and utility companies that serve them, the Tennessee General Assembly has charged the Commission with responsibility to ensure the provision of safe and reliable utility service at just and reasonable rates. Decisions of the Commission are made in the public interest and public involvement is vital to the effective discharge of the duties entrusted to the Commission. The TPUC issues this notice to foster transparency, clarify procedure, and encourage public participation in the Commission's proceedings. It is not necessary to formally intervene or be a party to provide input in a proceeding before the Commission. The public is invited to submit informal comments to the Commission in several ways:
