Change in Tire Pre-disposal Fee

Public Chapter 602 (2007)

Tire pre-disposal fee notice #07-06

Effective October 1, 2007, Chapter 602, Public Acts of 2007, amends Tennessee Code Annotated Section 67-4-1603 by increasing the tire predisposal fee from \$1.00 to \$1.35 per new tire sold in Tennessee.

Also, Public Chapter 602 amends Tenn. Code Ann. Section 67-4-1610 to change amount of deduction a dealer can take for filing the tire pre-disposal fee return in a timely manner. The fee is changed from ten percent of the amount due on the return to ten cents per tire reported on line 1 of the return.

Finally, the provision in Tenn. Code Ann. Section 67-4-1605(b) relative to the credit for purchase of a tire shredder is abolished in its entirety.
