

Tennessee High Performance Building Requirements (TN HPBr) Summary of Changes

January 17, 2020 to July 1, 2021

HPBr Manual:

- Page 35, EQ10.2 – Revised the section naming system for *Views from Occupied Spaces*, from Section EQ10.2 to Section EQ11.1 to match naming system indicated in the *HPBr Checklist Workbook*.

HPBr Checklist Workbook:

- In the *Credit Verification* tab of the *HPBr Checklist Workbook*, formulas within cells E71 – E79 (Materials and Resources) were revised to accurately reference *Project Team Representative* initials provided in the *Checklist Workbook* tab.

June 14, 2019 to January 17, 2020

HPBr Manual:

- Page 23, MR2.1 – Changed 3-point landfill diversion threshold from 90% to 95% to align with all other such references to this requirement in the HPBr documentation as originally intended by HPBr development consultant, Smith, Seckman Reid.
- Added definitions for Fuel Efficient Vehicle and Low Emitting Vehicle.
- Replaced HPBr OPR Applicability Tree with high resolution version.

May 18, 2018 to June 14, 2019
