Kandace Christopher Voluntary Surrender

The Background:

Facts: Educator was a high school teacher in Alabama. Educator resigned from her teaching

position in Alabama amid allegations of sexual misconduct with a student. Educator was charged with one felony count and one misdemeanor count of school employee having sexual contact with a student under age nineteen. Educator voluntarily surrendered her

license in Alabama on May 5, 2015.

Status: Respondent was notified by certified mail, return receipt requested, of the Board's intent

to revoke her educator license based upon these findings. Respondent received said

notice.

The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(e) and (2)(f).

The Board staff recommends that the Board approve the signed Consent Order submitted by the Respondent for the voluntary surrender of her license.
