The Background:

Facts: In 2013, Educator's license was revoked for taking the PRAXIS exam on behalf of

applicants for educator licensure in Tennessee. She pled guilty to Conspiracy to Defraud the United States in 2012 for these actions. On August 8, 2018, Educator submitted her application to restore her Tennessee educator license. Educator submitted her own personal statement as part of her application for restoration, as well as various letters of recommendation from colleagues. Since her revocation, she has completed professional

counseling and has tutored at-risk children through her church.

Status: Respondent was notified by electronic mail on October 10, 2018, of the Board staff's

recommendation to grant restoration of her license at the Board's next regularly

scheduled meeting.

The Recommendation:

Pursuant to Board Policy 5.500, the Board staff recommends that Educator's license be restored based upon the policy considerations deemed relevant by the Board to show that an educator has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant license restoration.
