
Southwest Early College High School Revocation Appeal

The Background:

On September 18, 2019, the Shelby County Schools (SCS) Office of Charter Schools issued a notice to the Governing Board chair of Southwest Early College High School (SECHS) informing the Governing Board of the SCS Office of Charter Schools' intention to recommend the revocation SECHS's charter agreement to the SCS Board of Education. At its October 29, 2019 board meeting, the SCS Board of Education voted to revoke the SECHS charter agreement, pursuant to T.C.A. § 49-13-122(b)(1).

On November 8, 2019, the Governing Board of SECHS appealed the revocation of its charter agreement to the State Board of Education (State Board). The State Board conducted a de novo on the record review of documentation submitted by both SCS and SECHS and held a public hearing on December 4, 2019 in Memphis. The Executive Director based the recommendation on the review of the record, information presented at the public hearing, and the public comment received on this appeal.
