
Repeal Charter School Amendment and Appeals Rule 0520-14-01-.06

The Background:

State Board Rule 0520-14-01-.06 governs the timeline and process for a charter school to amend a charter agreement and appeal an amendment petition denial by a local board of education to the State Board of Education pursuant to T.C.A. § 49-13-110. In May 2021, the Tennessee General Assembly passed Public Chapter 493 which transferred charter school amendment timeline and appeal process authority from the State Board of Education to the Tennessee Public Charter School Commission.

The Commission brought emergency rules to govern the amendment timeline and appeal process to their July 13, 2021 meeting. In order to complete the transition of amendment authority to the Commission, this item proposes a repeal of section .06 of the State Board rule that governs the amendment and appeal processes.

The Recommendation:

The SBE staff recommends acceptance of this item on first reading.
