A RESOLUTION to honor Senator Jim Tracy of Shelbyville, Tennessee, for meritorious service on the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations.

WHEREAS, Senator Tracy has served his community as a member of the Senate from the

104th through 110th General Assemblies, being first elected in 2004;

WHEREAS, Senator Tracy has, among other assignments, served as Senate Speaker Pro

Tempore, Assistant Floor Leader of the Senate Republican Caucus, the Chair of the Senate

Transportation and Safety Committee, Vice-Chair of the Senate State and Local Government

Committee, and a member of the Senate Education Committee, the Council for Pensions and

Insurance Joint Committee, the Joint Veterans Affairs Committee; the Long Term Care Advisory

Council, and the Commission on Aging and Disabilities;

on the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations from April 2007 to

November 2017 helping provide leadership and direction to the Commission's staff; now,
