

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT
STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Tennessee Department of Transportation seeks comments on Amendment #70 to the 2023-2026 State Transportation Improvement Program. Amendment #70 is for the new Clay County Project Number 23142952019 which provides \$4,700,000 in Fiscal Year 2024 STBG funding, replacing the \$2,300,000 in Fiscal Year 2023 STBG funds for Right-of-Way due to the latest estimate. The estimated total project cost accordingly increases from \$22,000,000 to \$24,400,000. The 0.86-mile-long project on SR-52 extends from near Kyle Street to existing SR-52 near Washington Street. It is to be constructed on new location to facilitate the movement of truck traffic through Celina. The project is to be managed and let to contract by TDOT.
