TennCare Medication Therapy Management (MTM) Pilot Checklist

March 2020

- Tennessee License: Pharmacists must have a valid Tennessee license and meet minimum insurance requirements (i.e. professional liability insurance).
- **TennCare Medicaid ID:** Participating pharmacists must acquire a **TennCare Medicaid ID**.
 - Information on provider registration and access to the portal can be located on the TennCare Provider Registration website: <u>https://www.tn.gov/tenncare/provider-registration.html</u>
 - Provider registration is a two-step process where providers must complete CAQH process prior to TennCare registration.
 - IMPORTANT: CAQH: <u>https://proview.caqh.org/Login/Index?ReturnUrl=%2f</u>
 - Individual providers will submit information that will place the provider on the CAQH roster for TennCare/Tennessee Medicaid. Information and links, including a FAQ document, can be located at the website above.
 - Once data is received from CAQH and approved, a Medicaid ID will be assigned. Note also that TennCare will
 automatically receive your profile data from CAQH each time you make an update.
- Collaborative Practice Agreement: MTM pharmacists must have a written formal Collaborative Practice Agreement (CPA) in place with a provider affiliated with a TennCare PCMH or THL organization.
 - The CPA allows the practice to establish pharmacist expectations, scope of practice, and parameters relating to the MTM services.

- MCO Credentialing: MTM pharmacists must complete the MCO credentialing and network contracting (A copy of the CPA is required to complete this process).

- <u>CCT Training</u>: Pharmacists participating in the MTM pilot program must document in the Care Coordination Tool (CCT) platform.
 Please refer to the MTM provider manual for complete documentation requirements.
 - Pharmacists must complete the onboarding registration, training, and access process for the CCT.
 - After the CPA has been submitted to the MCOs, the pharmacist may initiate CCT training by emailing: <u>TennCare.Pharmacy.AdobeSign@tn.gov</u>
 - Please include the following information in email request:
 - NPI
 - TennCare ID
 - Name of TennCare PCMH or HL Organization
 - Name(s) of Pharmacist(s)
 - Email address (contact information)
 - Copy of pharmacist signed CPA attestation/addendum
- **CCT access** will be granted after the MCO credentialing process is completed.
 - o Acceptable Use Policy and Remote Access Request Forms (electronic process) must be signed.
 - Please email <u>TennCare.Pharmacy.AdobeSign@tn.gov</u> to initiate process.
- ALL registration steps listed above must be completed prior to providing MTM services and submitting claims for reimbursement.
