# **Annual Episodes Design Feedback Session**

- There were over 100 attendees across the six cities: Nashville, Chattanooga, Knoxville, Johnson City, Jackson, and Memphis.
- The Annual Episodes Design Feedback Session provides the opportunity for the public to comment on what is working well with each episode's clinical design and where providers would suggest changes for next year.
- 27 episodes of care in performance (Waves 1 6) were open for public feedback.
- This event took place simultaneously in six locations across the state linking clinicians, administrators, payers and other stakeholders by video-conference.





## **Next Steps Following this Feedback Session**

- Review all feedback received both prior and during the feedback session
- Analyze the potential changes and possible impact on episode design
- Release memo summarizing changes to episode design in September 2018
- Incorporate changes that need to be made for the 2019 performance period





# **Pausing Future Episode Design**

- The state will be pausing the design of future episodes in order to dedicate more resources toward maintaining and improving the 48 existing episodes. This includes continuing to improve provider engagement and analysis of episode performance data.
- The following episodes will be paused:
  - The 20 episodes in waves 10 and 11 that have not been designed
  - The 5 episodes with incomplete design due to data issues: Neonatal 31 weeks or less, Neonatal 32 to 36 weeks, Neonatal 36 weeks or more, Mastectomy, and Breast Cancer Medical Oncology
- There will be no episodes Technical Advisory Groups held this fall.
