Episode Design

- **Trigger:** pancreatitis diagnosis
- Quarterback type: facility (pancreatitis diagnosis site)
- Care included: all pancreatitis-related care including specific imaging and testing, specific medications, and specific surgical and medical procedures

Sources of Value

- Appropriate use of imaging and testing
- Appropriate use of critical care setting
- Appropriate length of stay
- Identification of root cause of exacerbation
- Appropriate management/resolution of root cause
- Appropriate use of procedural treatment
- Appropriate use of analgesia during hospital stay and on discharge
- Appropriate use of narcotics
- Appropriate follow up and management of root cause
- Reduction in avoidable readmissions
- Appropriate management of complications

Informational Only

- Nutritional counseling
- New narcotics prescription
- Multiple narcotics prescription
- Readmissions
- ED visits
- ERCP performed
- Cholecystectomy performed
- Relevant laboratory test
- Difference in average morphine equivalent dose (MED) per day

Making Fair Comparisons

Exclusions

- Business exclusions: inconsistent enrollment, third-party liability, dual eligibility, FQHC/RHC, no PAP ID, incomplete episodes, overlapping episodes
- Clinical exclusions: different care pathway (e.g., COVID-19, cystic fibrosis, immunity disorder, organ transplant, DCS custody)
- Patient exclusions: age (greater than 64 years old), death, left against medical advice
- High-cost outlier: episodes with risk-adjusted spend greater than three standard deviations above the average risk-adjusted episode spend for valid episodes are excluded.

Risk adjustment is used to ensure appropriate comparisons between patients.
