SUBJECT: Title VI Implementation Plan Update and Compliance Report

ACTION RECOMMENDED: Information

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Since June 30, 1994, each state agency that receives federal funds is required to file with the Comptroller of the Treasury a Title VI implementation plan. The purpose of the plan is show how the state agency, and the entities to which its federal funds flow, is assuring compliance of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of a persons race, color or national origin.

A copy of the Commission's Title IV Plan Update and Compliance report has been previously provided to you. Staff will provide an overview of the report and its key provisions.
