**SUBJECT:** Approval of New Programs under the Postsecondary Authorization Act

**ACTION RECOMMENDED:** Approval

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** The Commission, under the Postsecondary Authorization Act, has the “power and duty” to act upon applications for authorization of educational programs in the state. The Committee on Postsecondary Educational Institutions, which is a review and advisory committee to the Commission, met on January 8, 2009 and affirmed staff recommendations for approval.

involved in public auctioning of automobiles and will focus on legal and business issues unique to the sale and transfer of the title of motor vehicles in Tennessee. Students will receive instruction in auction laws, Tennessee motor vehicle laws, business practices, contracts, escrow accounts, and liability issues.

## **O. South College**

The first year, students will study subjects such as: biochemistry, pathophysiology, medicinal chemistry, pharmacology, pharmaceuticals and Introductory Pharmacy Practice Experiences. The second year, students will gain extensive knowledge of pharmacotherapy and continuation in the Pharmacy Practice course. The third year, students focus on experiential education and complete eight (8) Advanced Practice Experiences in five (5) week rotations consisting of six (6) required and two (2) elective rotations. Graduates will be eligible to sit for the North American Pharmacy Licensing Examination (NAPLEX) and the jurisprudence examination in the State of Tennessee.

South College has contacted the Tennessee Board of Pharmacy to inform them of the institution's intent to establish a South College School of Pharmacy.
