

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Wildlife Officer Applicants must:

- Possess a bachelors degree in wildlife or fish management, biological sciences, agricultural sciences, forestry, zoology or a closely related field with at least 20 semester hours of wildlife or fisheries related courses.
- Possess or obtain a valid vehicle operators license.
- Pass a psychological and physical exam, including drug screenings by a licensed physician contracted by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.
- Be 21 years of age on the closing application date.
- Be able to work outdoors in extremely hot or cold weather.
- Successfully complete a written and oral interview board examination.
- Successfully graduate from the Tennessee Wildlife Officers Training Academy.
