## Summary

Tennessee's April seasonally adjusted unemployment rate slightly decreased to $5.0 \%$ from the March revised rate of $5.1 \%$.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased from $15.8 \%$ to $5.0 \%$ while the national rate decreased from $14.8 \%$ to $6.1 \%$.

Total nonfarm employment increased 9,800 jobs from March to April. The largest increases occurred in retail trade, accommodation/food services, and professional/scientific/technical services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 287,400 jobs. The largest increases occurred in leisure/hospitality, trade/transportation/utilities, and manufacturing.
