Summary

Tennessee's April seasonally adjusted unemployment rate slightly decreased to 5.0% from the March revised rate of 5.1%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased from 15.8% to 5.0% while the national rate decreased from 14.8% to 6.1%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 9,800 jobs from March to April. The largest increases occurred in retail trade, accommodation/food services, and professional/scientific/technical services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 287,400 jobs. The largest increases occurred in leisure/hospitality, trade/transportation/utilities, and manufacturing.





Seasonally Adjusted - 2019 to 2021




Unemployment Rates - US & Tennessee Seasonally Adjusted - January 2014 to April 2021
