Summary

Tennessee's July seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased slightly to 9.5% from the June revised rate of 9.6%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased from 3.4% to 9.5% while the national rate increased from 3.7% to 10.2%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 600 jobs from June to July. The largest increases occurred in leisure/hospitality, professional/business services, and manufacturing.

Over the year, nonfarm employment decreased 160,600 jobs. The largest decreases occurred in leisure/hospitality, manufacturing, and professional/business services.






