Summary

Tennessee's June seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased to 9.7% from the May revised rate of 11.0%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased from 3.4% to 9.7% while the national rate increased from 3.7% to 11.1%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 108,500 jobs from May to June. The largest increases occurred in leisure/hospitality, government, and education and health services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment decreased 154,000 jobs. The largest decreases occurred in leisure/hospitality, manufacturing, and professional/business services.






