Summary

Tennessee's May seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased to 11.3% from the April revised rate of 15.5%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased from 3.5% to 11.3% while the national rate increased from 3.6% to 13.3%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 93,900 jobs from April to May. The largest increases occurred in leisure/hospitality, manufacturing, and other services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment decreased 265,800 jobs. The largest decreases occurred in leisure/hospitality, manufacturing, and professional/business services.






