Summary

Tennessee's November seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased slightly to 3.3% from the October revised rate of 3.4%

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained the same at 3.3% to while the national rate declined from 3.7% to 3.5%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 9,200 jobs from October to November. The largest increases occurred in manufacturing, leisure/hospitality, and educational/health services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 46,700 jobs. The largest increases occurred in leisure/hospitality, professional/business services, and educational/health services.





Seasonally Adjusted - 2017 to 2019




Unemployment Rates - US & TennesseeSeasonally Adjusted - January 2012 to November 2019
